



[Curious Reads] A Book of Changes by Daryl Lim Wei Jie



I love the frank moments in *Kangchu* where the author parallels a grumpy (or perhaps 'typical') man's thoughts in modern day Singapore to the '*Kangchu*' system (a socio-economic system of organisation developed by Chinese agricultural settlers). Yep. Sounds complicated, but it really isn't. But the poem is really LOL.
